firmly believed that there had to be something more than just coming to church every Sunday. I wanted more; I needed more! I desired change, and I hated my life, and oh, how I needed a change.

On that Friday, October the 16th, 1998, I was so desperate to find God, so I chose the book, 'Faith is the Victory' [Brother Branham] from my bookshelf to read on my way to work. I was at the point where I could not eat nor sleep; I just needed to know God. I needed the Holy Ghost to come to me.

That morning as I was reading the book, I came to the chapter where the Prophet talked about the woman with the issue of blood and how she longed to touch the hem of Jesus' garment.

I began to speak to God in my heart, and I asked Him how to touch the hem of His garment. I said, "Please show me because I do not know how to do it."

At my job that day, all I could think of was how to touch the hem of His garment. We usually have Prayer Service on Friday nights, and whenever I am going to be late for service, I would call Pastor Nelson and let him know that I was going to be late.

On my way to service, I kept thinking of praying to God about the situation. I felt the forces of hell against me, and I knew the devil was trying to stop me from getting to service on time. In addition, the public train was late, so I knew that I would not make it to service on time.

Prayer Service begins at 8:00 pm, and I got off the train at 8:24 pm, so I said to myself, I would only miss the song service, but I will get there in time for prayer.

When I reached the church, I pulled the outer door and went in, and I could hear the Saints including the ushers praying. I pulled the inside door to go in, but they had locked it. My heart leaped because I was locked out. I knocked quietly on the door, but I knew that no one would hear me because I knew that the Holy Spirit is very timid, and if He were dealing with someone, I did not want to disturb Him.

I felt sad and very jealous as I wanted to join the Saints in prayer. The devil said, "You can pray out here." I said, "No I want to go inside." Then in my heart, I said, "Lord God, if you are going to fill me with the Holy Ghost tonight, make Brother Nelson walk from the pulpit and come and open this door for me."

I put down my purse and leaned against the wall; I felt so sad; I began to cry. Even though I said that simple prayer, I thought nothing of it. I decided to wait. Then suddenly, Brother Nelson was standing at the door, holding it open for me to enter. I was so shocked and humbled by it; I knew that God heard my prayer, and I could feel His presence all over me.

I rushed into the sanctuary and fell on my knees. I cried out to God. I let go of everything I had in my heart. I told him that I could not deal with it anymore; That I needed help. I let go of myself, my hurts, the pain, and all my fears. Then I shouted to Him, "Give me what is mine!" Suddenly, it seems as though a power came from on high and pushed its way into my heart. I could not understand what was happening to me; I felt so good and happy and free!

I danced before the Lord, then I said to God, "Lord, if that was You, do it again." I continued to worship God. Suddenly the power of God swept me off my feet. I knew it was Him confirming to me. That was about 8:34 pm on October the 16th, 1998; the Lord filled me with the Holy Spirit.

I have never been the same since, and I will never forget it as long as I live.

n 2004, I was taken from work with severe abdominal pain and vomiting to my family doctor to check out the cause, and he diagnosed that I had gall stones. However, it got progressively worse the following morning, and I went to the Emergency department at the hospital. They did an ultrasound of my abdomen and found that gall stones were blocking the duct.

was returning from Brother Ben and Sister Monique's wedding in Brampton around midnight on a Saturday. One block and one set of traffic lights before my turn, I was going through the traffic light at the intersection of Lawrence and Bellamy.

To my left, I could hear a car accelerating. The car was coming towards me even though I had the green light, and it was clear that it was speeding up and not slowing down. We collided.

The impact sent my car to the far-right lane. My engine was in smoke, and there was a lot of commotion around me. My face was injured, and I felt excruciating pain in my side (the side in the collision). My feet under the steering wheel were trapped. The Police Officer at the scene told me to stay calm. He turned the engine off and said to me that they could not open my car door. The fire truck was on its way, and the Police officer came through the back door of my vehicle to talk to me until the fire truck arrived. The firemen pulled the door off the car and put a brace around my neck. The ambulance followed shortly after that. I was having terrible pain in my left side, so they took me to the Trauma Centre at St. Michael's Hospital in downtown Toronto. The medical staff at the hospital ran various tests, X-Rays, and CT scans.

My daughter was with me when they released me at 3 am that morning. I took a taxi back to Scarborough to the scene of the accident. My vehicle was a write-off and towed to be pounded. The passenger of the other vehicle was taken to the hospital and later died. Police had still blocked off the intersection for further investigation. I thank God that He was with my daughter and me that Saturday night. I experienced Him that day as Jehovah Nissi, The Lord my Banner. No weapon that is formed against me shall prosper. He promised that I shall not die but live to declare His Glory to this generation.

Over the years, she opened her home time and time again, to help the


