How I received the Holy Ghost

God bless you Saints.

I'm happy to share this testimony of how I received the Holy Ghost, to give God praise and to encourage my brothers and sisters in Christ.

I came to Canada on January 07, 2021. God led me to Perfect Love Tabernacle church by a testimony.

Before attending this church, I believed I received the Holy Ghost when I accepted this end-time Message. From my first day at Perfect Love Tabernacle, God started to deal with me by hearing the Word. And when the Pastor began to preach by quoting the scripture; Acts 19:2, "Have you received the Holy Ghost since you believed?" I had read this scripture so many times in my life, but after I heard the preaching, I started to notice it's not when "you believed," but it is **"Since You Believed."** From there onwards, I started to think and pray, "God, what is this all about? Give me that experience Lord."

After coming to church regularly, I began to grow and understand how important it is to receive the baptism of the Holy Ghost in my life journey towards God. I started to understand and realized that "it is essential and necessary, and compelling and compulsory."

I worked in a factory for cash not correctly registered (illegal) until June 2021. So, whenever I prayed or came to church with the expectation of receiving the Holy Ghost, there was a heavy burden on me that I couldn't get the Holy Ghost until I got things right. I couldn't concentrate on my work or anything. These things kept bothering me when I prayed or worked in the factory. I talked with our Pastor regarding this, and he spoke the Word to me. After a month, I prayed, "God, I need the Holy Ghost regardless of what," and I quit the work in June. So much of family pressures and surrounding pressures because I left the job. But I determined, whatever happens, I'm not going to give up until I receive the Holy Ghost.

I decided to make myself right towards God to receive the Holy Spirit. The Lord started to move and met every need in my life. As the days went by, my expectation of receiving the Holy Ghost grew. I faced battles, but somehow, I kept my expectation growing by prayer and continuously going to church to listen to His Word.

October 27th, 2021, Wednesday after night service, I took the subway to reach home. I started to play a tape until I came home. I randomly selected a message without knowing anything about that specific tape. It was **God's Provided Approach to Divine Fellowship** – **60-0630**. While I was listening to a particular part, a specific quote started to speak to my soul. The anointing came upon me, and I began to pray and determined I don't care about my studies, whatever it is, even though I go back to my home: "Give me that Holy Ghost Lord!" Tears started to run down while I was on the subway train. I reached home, and I knew that coming Friday, October 29th, our church would pray for the people who had not yet received the Holy Ghost.

The next day, my body felt so weak, but I kept pressing on the Lord.

On Friday, October 29th, I went to a nearby park to pray and have a quiet time in the morning. I started to pray as usual, but my body felt so weak that I couldn't concentrate on praying. Then I began to play a tape again randomly. The name of the message was **Why**, --60-0309. While the message was going, a specific quote started to speak to me like before. There were so many quotes that directly spoke to me. I got down on my knees because of these words **''If you don't get it**, **the Lord is going to ask you ''Why didn't you get it? Why? It was there for you.''** These quotes started to hear in my ears even though the tape finished. And I lifted my hands and prayed to the Lord, and I came to church with an expectation.

I never faced any battles like the specific night while I came to church, so many struggles and obstacles came in front of me, but I determined and took my decision. "This day, this night, Holy Ghost is mine. I won't go home until I receive it. When the Pastor lays his hands on me, I will receive it. It is God's promise to me."

Saints, I spoke the word "born again" so many times in my life journey, but I tasted what is born again on the specific night of **October 29th, 2021**. I saw my sins washed away. I felt all-new, all whitewashed by the Lamb's blood. I don't have words to describe it. Now I know Holy Ghost born again is not a word; it's a reality and an experience.

He Will Not Forget You

Recently, I was listening to a message on the internet, and the preacher in his preamble spoke about the needs of God's children. He took for his text Luke 18. *Then Jesus told his disciples a parable to show them that they should always pray and not give up.* And he spoke about the persistent widow. Then this testimony came to mind.

I quit my job as a sales clerk in the Gift Store at Timehri International Airport, Guyana in 1970. I had to stay at the Canadian Guess house to be on time on the job when the airplanes went out and came in. It was hard for me to be in church in Georgetown, where I lived. And I was among unbelievers, so it was difficult for me as a young Christian woman.

After I quit my job, God had provided another job for me in Georgetown that same year, but I failed the test at the interview due to disobedience. God had to teach me obedience, and I learned obedience by Him closing opportunities for jobs.

In 1975, I was desperate for a job; I was so desperate that I was willing to do a seasonal job. The General Post Office in Georgetown was hiring seasonal workers for the Christmas season, and I had a Christian friend who worked there, and he was willing to assist me in getting a seasonal job there. He took my documents, and I was waiting to hear from him, but as time went by, there was no response. And there was a specific time for them to hire you for the season.

The Sunday morning before I got my new job, my neighbor's radio was on, and someone was singing. I don't remember the name of the song but what I remembered were the words that spoke to my heart, "**I** will never forget my chosen ones." Immediately, I knew that God had not forgotten me, and I knew that I would get a job that week. Then I thought of my friend who had my certificates, so I contacted him and told him to bring them the Wednesday night at church. After church, he gave them to me, and I went home determined to talk to God.

That night I said to God, "Lord, I am like that widow who had a need, and she went to the unjust judge to help, but he would not for a while. But when he saw her continual coming, it troubled him, and he feared that she would weary him, so he granted her request. I am going to weary you, Lord; I am going to tell you night and day that I need a job." It was like my spirit was praying; it was a spirit-to-spirit connection; my heart and the heart of God. When I finished praying, I slept like a baby. Jesus knew I was determined to weary Him.

The following day, I woke up with a peace that passed all understanding. Then the thought came to me to call the Ministry of Labor. I got dressed and went to my eldest sister's home to use her telephone to make the call. When I dialed the Ministry, the operator responded and asked me where I wanted her to direct my call. I told her that I needed to speak to the manager. She said they don't have a manager, just an assistant manager. I told her to put me through to him. She did, and he answered the phone. I gave him my name, and I asked if the General Post Office had already hired seasonal workers for the Christmas season. He said, "Yes." Then he asked me if I was looking for a job for someone. I told him that I was looking for a job for myself. He asked me what my qualifications were, and I told him what they were. Then he said to meet him at his office at 1 pm.

When I went down to his office, he sent me to the Ministry of Housing that same Thursday. Saturday was my first day in my new job as a typist clerk in the Ministry of Housing.

Brother Sam proceeded to show us how the little maid from Israel, a captive working with Naaman's wife, conducted herself as a believer spreading her light. When she heard about Naaman's secret, she began to testify to his wife about the God who heals diseases. Naaman's wife listened to her because she had the right attitude and created a healing atmosphere in the home. The maid told her about the prophet in Samaria who would recover Naaman of his leprosy, and she believed it and sent a message to him.

Naaman wanted to be delivered and be free from his leprosy, but his pride was in the way. Brother Sam explained how difficult it was for Naaman to get rid of his pride from the scripture. But when he got rid of it, he was able to go to Jordan and dip seven times in the muddy water as the prophet commanded him to do and was healed of his leprosy. Naaman's pride had to die. Likewise, our pride must die for us to receive the Holy Ghost.

Brother Sam shared his experience of dying out to be born again. He encouraged the young people to die out and get rid of the secret sin: pornography, worldly music, ugly posters, etc., to create the right atmosphere in their homes and emphasized the importance of the right atmosphere. He mentioned that Brother Branham said the atmosphere that brings the result, and he declared that Jesus is always knocking at the doors of our hearts to get inside.

He challenged the young people to come to Jordan and die out to receive the baptism of the Holy Ghost. He also invited them to Jordan to receive the **Double Portion**. Dying out is God's way, and that is the only way he declared to get rid of the secret sin and receive the baptism of the Holy Ghost.

The other speaker was Brother Joel Dickison, a young Christian who has a calling of God in his life. He stepped into the vision that Brother Sam declared and continued in that path: **Dying Out**.

His scripture readings were Luke 9:23, Mark 8:35, and Romans 8:13. Brother Joel elaborated and testified on Dying out.

He read from Brother Branham's Message, 'Christianity Versus Idolatry:'61-1217.

103 "Right in your heart, remember Christ the Saviour. Remember He died for you. And if you'll just die to yourself, that'll empty your body, empty your soul, empty you of everything is this world, and its pleasures, then Christ...You raise with Him."

He encouraged the young people to die out so that God could have first place in their lives. He also mentioned that the only way to receive freedom is dying out to ourselves. There is no other way. He, too, encouraged them to get rid of the posters, the music, etc., and die. He said you could not be a light if you are following darkness.

Like Brother Sam, he explained what it means to die out: Repent and be baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. He stayed on that for a while, showing the importance of God's way to remake us, and that is what we believe. And it is the Message—the Holy Ghost. God's way or no way!

God bless you both for yielding to the Holy Ghost.

I was tremendously blessed and encouraged with the Word that came forward by Brother Sam and Brother Joel Dickison.


