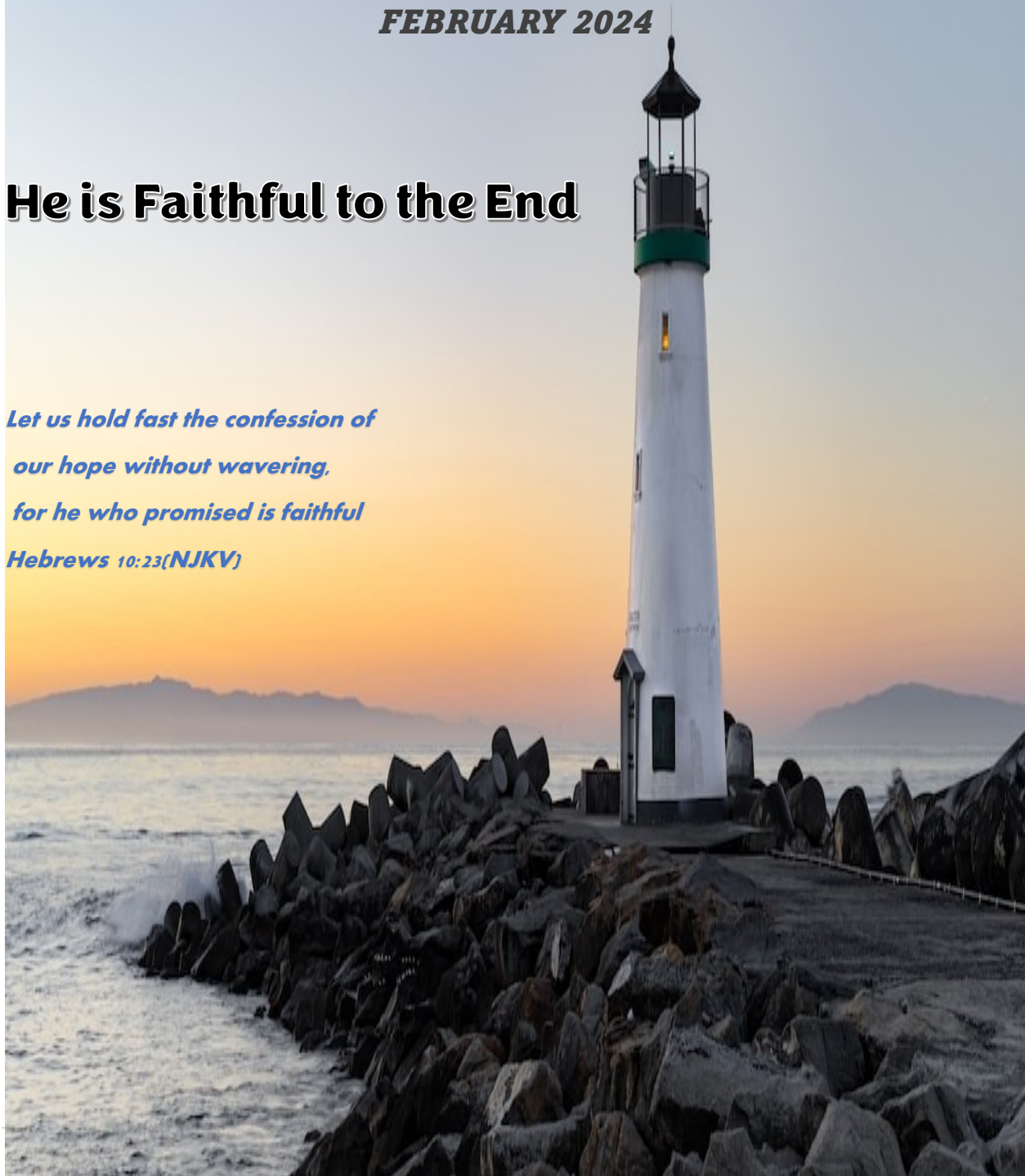

Pastor Nelson Visit to Mexico December 2023

We experienced the presence of God in our midst, the brotherly love, and the word preached to us in its season, by God's anointed ministers, flames of fire.

Years ago, Brother Nelson visited another church, and in that church a lady came to the prayer line, she was addicted to alcohol for more than 10 years. And in these meetings, she came and told us that from that moment she never tasted alcohol again, totally set free.

Years ago Brother Nelson visited another church, and in that church there was another church visiting, and in the prayer line came a lady, a pastor's wife, stricken with cancer, prayer was made on her behalf, and in these meetings she came to testify that the next day she went to the doctor for treatment, and the doctor told her you can go home, there is no cancer to treat.

During one of the 8 local services, Brother Nelson was ministering the word of God, the church was full of other believers from another church sitting in the patio of the church. A father with his 2- or 3-years old baby came running to the front of the church in desperation, crying out that his little baby is motionless and stopped breathing, interrupting the service going on. Brother Nelson took the baby in his arms and prayed, quickly the baby started crying, and the father thanked the Lord for bringing his baby back to life again.

They decided to take the baby to the hospital, and the doctor said, "there is nothing wrong, the baby is fine." After the service finished outside the church the believers started to worship, and no one wanted to go home.

Jesus Christ confirmed that he is the same yesterday today and forever. That's what is it to contend for the faith. Brother Branham said that to contend for the faith is to keep Jesus Christ alive in the church, doing the same thing he was doing when he was alive in the flesh with them in their midst.

REFLECTION

Great Is Thy Faithfulness by Sister Gail Hing

About two years ago, I experienced some financial changes in my life, which caused me to struggle to pay my apartment rent. At the beginning of my struggle, I sought the Lord for help, and the word "Faith," dropped into my heart. But I didn't recognize that it was the word from the Lord until He brought it to mind sometime later.

When I learned that the word "Faith" was from the Lord, I checked all the messages the prophet preached on "Faith" and listened to them, some of them repeatedly. Those messages strengthened my faith and encouraged my trust in the Lord as Jehovah Jireh, my Provider.

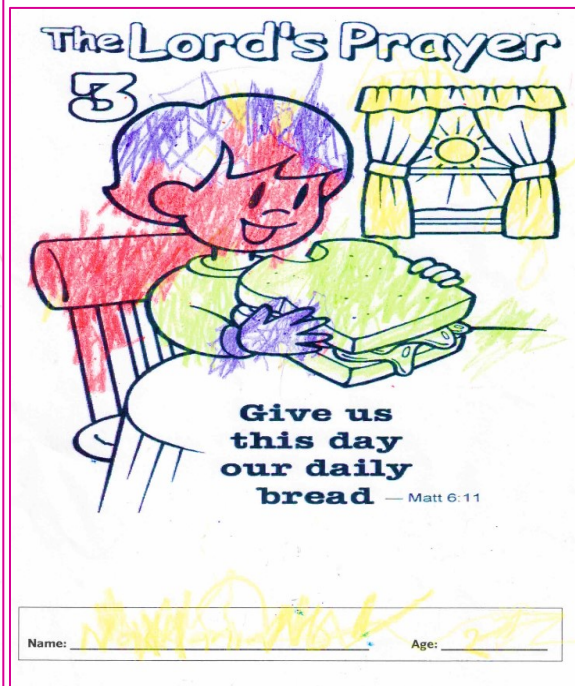
