

Time-Tested Faith

When Brother Paul Mohan from Trinidad visited our church, Perfect Love Tabernacle, on Sunday, March 30, 2025, he testified about the goodness of God towards him and his family. His testimony was such a profound blessing to the congregation, filling the atmosphere with joy and faith.

You can go to the service to hear his testimony directly from him.

Brother Paul said that God blessed him with two beautiful daughters and that he was praying for a son because he wanted his son to take over his business and carry on the family legacy.

He was on the mission field with Brother David Ross for the dedication of his church in Mahaicony, a village in Guyana, South America, when the Lord showed him that his son was coming. His wife was pregnant then. So, he said, "Okay, praise the Lord." And he went back home happy and rejoicing.



He told us that they had bought everything blue, a color traditionally associated with boys, and even prepared his room in blue as a symbol of their faith and anticipation for the arrival of a son.

His wife, who has had complicated pregnancies, had repeated ultrasounds leading up to the delivery, and all the ultrasounds showed that it was a girl.

She was discouraged, and she would cry, saying, "Maybe." Then, he would remind her of the prophet's testimony. The Lord had promised the prophet, Joseph, and some people were saying perhaps it was Josephine. Brother Paul told his wife that Daniel was coming, not Danielle.

On the morning of her delivery, they did another ultrasound and presented it to them ten minutes before delivery. There was no question about it; it was a girl, "plain as day." He said he told her not to doubt because the Lord said so, and it is so! He went to work, and when he got back to the hospital, his wife had already delivered the baby and was in recovery.

The nurses came to him and said, "Mr. Mohan, we don't know how to tell you this." They brought out the baby, clothed in pink, and a pink band indicating the mother's name. When Brother Paul saw his baby clothed in pink, he exclaimed, "What is this!" so he opened the pampers. What he saw almost made him 'hit the roof.' It was a boy, a miraculous twist that left everyone in awe.

The nurses said they didn't know what happened because all the ultrasound examinations had shown it was a girl. Brother Paul said, 'Praise the Lord; you would not understand.'

Even though they passed the first test, God would have them undergo a second test.

The baby was born with an extreme case of club feet, a condition where the feet turned inward. Brother Paul explained to us how the baby's legs were intertwined, and the doctor said that the child would never walk or live an everyday life. He would be a special child, requiring extra care and attention. So, he said to the doctor, 'Praise God; if God wanted it, so be it.'

That night, they attended church, where the pastor, Brother Green, and the congregation united in prayer for them, a powerful demonstration of their shared faith in God and their commitment to support one another.

Brother Paul said that he asked the Lord how it could be when he gave up everything for Him and dedicated his life to serving His kingdom; however, he said to the Lord, "Nevertheless, your will be done."

Then he sought counsel from the 'Message' but found nothing regarding his case. So, he sought counsel from his pastor, who is in the medical field. His pastor told him that unless he heard from God, he must follow the doctor's advice.

Brother Paul said he was assigned three of the country's leading specialists to handle his case. One of them was a Muslim from Pakistan, and he was the one with the most experience in that kind of case. He suggested that they would break the baby's feet several times throughout his life to try and straighten them. That was hard for him and his wife to accept, so he went crying to his pastor, who repeated what he had said before: unless you hear from God, follow the doctor's advice.

Twenty-eight days after the baby was born, they scheduled the first appointment to break his legs. Brother Paul had met a Christian couple while living in Trinidad, Brother and Sister Ramlall, and they became very close to his family. They were like grandparents to him, and he admired how close they were to God.

On the morning of their first appointment, he was already in his vehicle, ready to drive off to the hospital, when the phone rang. He said he usually doesn't go back inside once he is already in his vehicle. But that time, he went back inside to answer the call. It was Sister Ramlall on the phone. She told him that the Lord had instructed her that morning to tell him not to let them break his feet. Sister Ramlall emphasized, "Whatever they do, don't let them break his feet." She said God didn't tell her what they should do. He only said to tell him, don't let them break his feet.

Brother Paul went to the hospital and told the doctors that he would not be signing any document to break his baby's feet. He said to them that God told him not to hurt his feet. But that's what we're here for, the doctors said in astonishment. They asked him what they were supposed to do; if not to break his feet, then what? Then Brother Paul repeated what God said. The leading doctor told him, 'Your God is not here.' I am the one handling the case. Brother Paul said to him that if he cannot take the leadership of God, he should not be there. Then he walked out, leaving the two doctors to decide.

Brother Paul said that the two doctors looked at each other like Alice in Wonderland, scratching their heads in confusion. They left and returned about an hour later, telling him that they would apply Plaster of Paris to the baby's feet and, over time, attempt to straighten them. Brother Paul said to them that if that was the leadership, so be it.

That journey was challenging for the family because the baby had to be in public with his feet from the buttocks to the tip of his toes wrapped in Plastic of Paris. People looked at them in disgust, including some church people, and said offensive words, blaming them for the baby's condition. But the family's faith was unshaken. They soon realized that God was testing and humbling them, but they also found strength in their belief, which helped them overcome the public scrutiny and the challenges they faced.

Eventually, the baby's feet started to straighten, and everything that the doctors said he would not be able to do, his child did at the same speed, or even faster, than a normal child.

Brother Paul said that now his son's feet are straighter than his.

Reason No. 1

Reason No. 2

"*Tithing helps us to put God first.*" There is a great tendency in the world today to give God the leftovers, not only of our money, but also of our time and energy. If there is enough time left after we have finished the things we want to do, we may go to the prayer meeting. If there is enough time after we have listened to the news or visited our favorite website, we may read a few passages from the Bible. If there is any money left after we have purchased the things we want, we may put it into an envelope and call it "tithes."

Those who put God last in their finances will most likely put Him last in all of life's important issues. But those who honor God with their tithes will most likely put Him first in all matters of importance. The Bible tells us, "Honor the Lord with thy substance, and with the first fruits of thine increase. So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine" (Proverbs 3:10). "Are you giving to God your leftovers?"

Reason No. 3

"*We cannot excel as Christians without tithing.*" The words of Jesus are very clear at this point. "For I say unto you, that except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the Scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter the kingdom of heaven," (Matthew 5:20). The Scribes and Pharisees did not always keep the spirit of the law, but they were strict tithers. We can never exceed what they did, nor can we do any less. "How do you stand at this point, ahead or behind the Scribes and Pharisees?"

Reason No. 4

"To fail to pay tithes is to rob God." Will a man rob God? Such a question is deemed absurd! How inconceivable to think that mortal man would rob God...the strength of his life, the source of all blessings both temporal and spiritual, and his only future hope. Yet God said through the inspired prophet: "Ye have robbed me in tithes and offerings. Ye are cursed with a curse, for ye have robbed me, even this whole nation," (Malachi 3:8-9).




